

## Spanish Phrases for Mission

### INTRODUCING / GREETING

Hello, my name is May. It's a pleasure to meet you! Sorry, I only speak very little Spanish. I only speak English.

**Hola, me llamo May. Es un placer conocerte! Yo solamente hablo Inglés y muy poquito español.**

What's your name?  
**Cómo te llamas?**

How are you?  
**Cómo estás?**

Very nice to meet you!  
**Es un placer conocerte**

Do you understand English?  
**Entiendes Inglés?**

Do you speak English?  
**Hablas Inglés?**

I'd like to introduce you to my friend Dave.  
**Me gustaría presentarte a mi amigo Dave**

Good morning.  
**Buenos días.**

Good afternoon.  
**Buenas tardes.**

Good evening.  
**Buenas noches.**

Happy Birthday!  
**Feliz cumpleaños!**

I've missed you.

**Te he extrañado (to one only)**  
**Los he extrañado (to more than one)**

I'll miss you.  
**Te extrañaré (to one only)**

**Los extrañaré (to more than one)**

See you soon.  
**Hasta pronto**

Be good until I see you next time.  
**Pórtate bien / sé un buen niño (to one only)**  
**Pórtense bien y sean buenos niños (to more than one)**

### QUESTIONS

Say it again? (asking the child to repeat something in case they were talking too fast or I couldn't understand)  
**Dilo otra vez?**

How old are you?  
**Cuántos años tienes?**

Who's your best friend?  
**Quién es tu mejor amigo?**

When is your birthday?  
**Cuándo es tu cumpleaños?**

What do you want to be when you grow up?

**Qué quieres ser cuando seas grande?**

What sports do you like?  
**Qué deportes te gustan?**

What do you like to do?  
**Qué te gusta hacer?**

Are you hungry?  
**Tienes hambre?**

Are you thirsty?  
**Tienes sed?**

What's your favorite color?  
**Cuál es tu color favorito?**

Do you know how to pray?  
**Sabes rezar?**

Where is the bathroom? May I use the bathroom?  
**Dónde está el baño?**  
**Puedo usar el baño?**

### STATEMENTS

I like (exercising and taking pictures).  
**Me gusta (hacer ejercicios y tomar fotos).**

I'm from the United States of America. The state I live in is California.  
**Yo soy de los Estados Unidos. El estado donde yo vivo es California.**

I have a brother. His name is Alfredo.  
**Yo tengo un hermano. El se llama Alfredo.**

I have a nephew. His name is Lorenzo.

**Yo tengo un sobrino. El se llama Lorenzo.**

Thank you for sharing. (when the child tells me something about themselves or how they're feeling).

**Gracias por haber compartido.**

### COMMENTS/REQUESTS

Give me a hug please.  
**Dame un abrazo por favor.**

Let's go. (inviting them to walk with me somewhere - like to go eat or to the playground or to play basketball or do arts and crafts)

**Mexican way: Andale vamos! ;)**

**Spanish: Vamos a... (let's go, let's do...)**

I'm tired.  
**Estoy cansada (cansada-feminine, cansado-masculine)**

I need rest.  
**Necesito descansar.**

I'm hungry.  
**Tengo hambre.**

### SAYING NO AND GIVING THE REASON

Sorry, Banqui, I can't let you video tape. The directors have asked only adults.  
**Lo siento Banqui. No te puedo dejar usar la cámara de video. Los directores dijeron que solamente los adultos pueden usarla.**

### CORRECTING

Don't touch!  
**No agarres eso!**

Be careful!  
**Ten cuidado!**

Don't hit!  
**No pegues!**

Don't kick!  
**No patees!**

Be good to (Junior).  
**Se buena con (Junior) (Buena-feminine, Bueno-masculine)**

Be good, (Florentino).  
**Se buena con (Florentino) (Buena-feminine, Bueno-masculine)**

That wasn't nice, (Florentino). Say you're sorry to (Banqui) and mean it.  
**Eso no estuvo bien, (Florentino). Dile a (Banqui) que de verdad lo sientes mucho**

### ENCOURAGING

You're a good child.  
**Tu eres un buen niño. (niña-feminine, niño-masculine)**

You're a smart child.  
**Tu eres un niño inteligente. (niña-feminine, niño-masculine)**

That's nice! (on what they did, designed, drew,

constructed - complimenting an object)  
**Muy bien! Eso! Bravo! Eso esta muy bonito! (That is very nice)**

You look nice. (or something to compliment their appearance - masculine and feminine)  
**Se te ve muy bien Te vez bonita. (bonita-feminine, bonito-masculine) – You look pretty**

Good job!  
**Buen trabajo!**

I'm proud of you!  
**Yo estoy orgullosa de ti!**

I'll keep you in my prayers.  
**Te mantendré en mis oraciones.**

I will pray for you and your intentions  
**Rezará por ti y tus intenciones**

I love you.  
**Te quiero mucho**

Jesus loves you.  
**Cristo/Jesús te ama**

Keep praying.  
**Sigue rezando**

**Pray always Reza siempre**
